The Race had a 2.0 Hour Time Limit, and was open to Male and Female Runners in Several Age Cat. I finished in 84mins.09secs.in79th, out of 103 finishers, and taking the 1st. Male O/70 Trophy.

Pembroke 10k Race, Challenging Road Course ,with Up-Hill Sections and Tight Turns. Race Organized by another Local Club Pembroke Athlete. This Race also open to both Male and Female Runners in Several Age Cat I had a good race against a Local St. Patrick's Male Runner we were side by side up around 6-7k point,when at the start of another Up- Hill Section I managed to pull away,Finishing around some 40 plus secs.ahead in51mins. 59secs.in 87th position out of 108 Finishers and taking the 1st Male O/70 Trophy,the Local Runner taking 1st O/65 Trophy,so we were both pleased.

Both Races were well organized and friendly events and made me very welcome, good value for the Entrance Fee ,Good Medal and pair of Ron Hill Running Socks at Dingli,Good Memento and goody bag with Tee-Shirt ect. at Pembroke,would put some of our UK Races to shame,eg. Covers 10.

Would I Run Again You Bet,at Dingli I would be on a Hat-Trick, having picked up the O/65 Trophy in 2007.
